

You hereby acknowledge and undertake to Studio Lambert Associates Limited (“Producer”) that in consideration of the Producer agreeing to consider this application you hereby agree to the following terms and conditions.

1. You confirm that you are aged 18 years or over on the date of submitting your application and a British National and/or have the right to reside in the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland and that you are not employed or engaged and have not been previously employed or engaged by any company within the All 3 Media Group or Channel 4 and you are not a live-in partner or immediate relative of an employee of or worker for any company within the All3Media Group or Channel 4. If you are, or have been, employed or engaged by, or are an immediate relative and/or a live-in partner of an employee of or worker for an All 3 Media Group company or Channel 4 you agree to inform us of this and you understand that we may decide to exclude you from further participation on this basis. Should your application be taken further you may be required to give proof that you are a British National or of your right to reside in the UK or the Republic of Ireland.
2. You confirm that the information supplied on the application form as well as all other information that you submit to the Producer will be true and honest, that you have not and will not deceive or mislead us in any way (including not withholding any information) and you will continue to be entirely truthful and accurate in answering any questions and/or supplying information to us whether verbally or in writing. You agree to keep the Producer informed of any change to these circumstances or to the information set out in your application form or to any other information that you otherwise submit to the Producer in connection with the programme.
3. If you have provided information relating to another person, including but not limited to contact information, you confirm to the Producer that you have obtained that person’s consent, having fully explained to them the purpose of providing the information.
4. Following our review of your application you may be put through to the second stage shortlist and asked for further information. Being shortlisted does not mean that you have been selected to appear on the Programme.
5. If you are shortlisted, we shall have the right to investigate and review the validity and authenticity of the information you submit (in any way that we may reasonably choose) and in the event that such investigation and/or review of the information reveals any information to be false or misleading, or if we discover something that we feel may adversely affect your suitability to participate in the Programme, we may, at our absolute discretion, discontinue your participation in the selection process and/or the programme.
6. You acknowledge that we will be carrying out background checks, including criminal record background checks, on all contributors. If you have anything in your past or you become involved in any criminal and/or civil proceedings or other conduct that may attract negative press or publicity at any time after submitting this application, you will make us aware of it

immediately. Disclosing something of this nature to us will not automatically disqualify you from taking part but it is important we know of any relevant issues.

7. All applicants will be required to disclose if they have ever been convicted of a criminal offence or have any criminal prosecutions pending or been the subject of an official police caution before taking part in the Programme. If the information you give to the Producer at any time about your prior convictions, pending police or judicial actions, suspended criminal proceedings or cautions is found to be false and/or misleading the Producer will be entitled to exclude you from the Programme selection process, or (if you are selected to take part) exclude you from participating or participating further in the Programme. Disclosing something of this nature to us will not automatically disqualify you from taking part but it is important we know of any relevant issues.
8. If you are shortlisted you agree to undergo a psychological assessment by an independent psychologist.
9. You agree that you will not at any time disclose to any third person (including without limitation the press, or via social media) any information in relation to this application or the selection process, the Programme, and/or our general affairs without our prior written consent.
